





Which AEDC domains?

We focus on communities where the percentage of children struggling across two or more developmental domains is greater than 20%.

PTTR Ltd has chosen to use all 5 AEDC Domains. Why? Based on practice wisdom and evidence based research early

literacy skills can impact all the domains

For example:

Physical – the same fine motor skills needed for writing can also impact on the ability to complete personal care.

The majority of children with language delay have socioemotional difficulties, and have difficult communicating effectively.


4. PTTR's outcomes

- In the interim, we collect Performance Accountability data.



Auburn Reading Day 2011



58 responses

- Knowledge
- 35% recognised importance of reading to their children from birth
- 37% learnt something new about reading to their children
- 27% remind them of something about reading to your children
- Attitude
- 95% enjoying the Reading Day
- Behaviour
- 38% will read more often with their children
- 37% will encourage their children to look at books








Penrith - Did we help turn the curve?




